

HOW TO GET A PENNSYLVANIA PHOTO IDENTIFICATION CARD

An identification card is issued to any Pennsylvania resident who is at least 16 years of age. This is not a driving product.

Process

Step 1:

Visit any [Driver License Center](#) and take along:

1. [Proof of identification](#)
2. Social Security Card
3. Check or money order in the amount of \$10 and two [acceptable forms of address verification](#) if applicant is 18 years or older.

Step 2:

Completed Form [DL-54A](#) "Application for Pennsylvania Photo Identification Card".

Step 3:

Upon handing in the proper identification requirements, a camera card is issued to you.

Step 4:

The camera card is taken to the photo technician co-located within the Driver License Center for the photo to be taken.

Step 5:

A Photo Identification Card is issued to you.
