In accordance with the settlement agreement between the United States and the City of Philadelphia, and the settlement between the parties in the above-captioned case, the United States provides this bi-monthly report for the period of April 1, 2010, to May 31, 2010, on the status of the United States' polling place surveys.

This report provides only a summary of the actual survey results. Copies of the surveys have been provided to all the parties. If the Court would like further information, copies of surveys can be provided as well.

### **ACCESSIBLE POLLING PLACES**

The following polling places have been surveyed by the United States and have been determined to be accessible under the standards agreed to in this case. We indicate the ward, division, name, and entrance location of each polling place. For these polling places, the main entrance used by voters on election day is also the accessible entrance.

### **POLLING PLACES THAT MAY BE MADE TEMPORARILY ACCESSIBLE ON ELECTION DAY**

The following polling places have been surveyed by the United States and have been determined to be inaccessible under the standards agreed to in this case. For these polling places, there is a temporary measure(s) that may make them accessible on election day. We include the temporary measures as well as the identification of the polling places and the primary entrance. Additionally, when there is an alternate accessible entrance, we indicate whether the accessible entrance should not be re-designated as the exclusive entrance and signs should be posted directing voters to the accessible entrance, or whether the accessible entrance should be

re-designated as the exclusive entrance. If an alternate entrance is not indicated, then the primary entrance and the accessible entrance are the same entrance.

Also included in this category are polling places that are otherwise accessible but the accessible entrance is not the primary entrance; a recommendation to re-designate the accessible entrance as the exclusive entrance is provided as a temporary remedy.

Additionally included in this category are polling places that are accessible but require signs to be posted to direct voters to an accessible entrance when it cannot be re-designated as the exclusive entrance. We include the reason why the accessible entrance should not be re-designated as the exclusive entrance.

Finally, we have included recommendations for permanent modifications for publicly-owned buildings where it may be reasonable to modify inaccessible features. Where appropriate, we have provided a recommendation as to how they may be reasonably, permanently modified to remove barriers to accessibility.

- Ward 1, Division 5, Office (McClellan Street)
  1. Keep garage door open.<sup>1</sup>
- Ward 4, Divisions 3, 9, Church Property (Ramped entrance at the corner of Cambridge Street & N. 56<sup>th</sup> Street)
  1. Re-locate voting area to the basement of the Vine Memorial Baptist Church (main building).
  2. Use the ramped entrance at the Church and allow voters in wheelchairs to use the lift to access the basement.

<sup>1</sup> The City has indicated to the Department that this polling site is located in the building's office space, not its garage. During the May 18, 2010 election, however, the polling place was located in the garage. The polling place should stay located in the garage because the office is not accessible.

- Ward 4, Division 16, Church Property (W. Girard Avenue)
  1. Re-locate voting area to the basement of the Vine Memorial Baptist Church (main building).
  2. Use the ramped entrance at the Church and allow voters in wheelchairs to use the lift to access the basement.
  
- Ward 5, Division 14, University of the Arts Building (Primary Entrance: Broad Street; Accessible Entrance: Pine Street)
  1. Place wedge at the base of the exterior ramp to address the 1 inch lip.
  2. Prop open interior doors.
  3. Tie temporary edge protection to exterior ramp posts.
  4. Make sure that guard or attendant responds to call button from the accessible entrance and assists with the operation of the lift.
  5. Do not make the accessible entrance the exclusive entrance because using the lift is the sole means of accessing the voting area from the accessible entrance.
  
- Ward 7, Division 14, Vietnam Vets Motorcycle Club (North Front Street)
  1. Prop open both leaves of entrance door.
  2. Place 2 foot temporary ramp over 1.5 inch interior level change, which is located 5 feet, 9 inches from the building entrance.
  
- Ward 10, Divisions 9, 10, Grace Temple Baptist Church (North 16<sup>th</sup> Street)
  1. Prop open both leaves of entrance door.
  2. Place 6 foot temporary ramp at the exterior step (next to the existing short ramp, which is too steep).
  
- Ward 11, Division 11, Cambria Business and Resource Center (Cambria Street)
  1. Prop open both entry and vestibule doors.
  2. Place temporary wedge at vestibule doors for 1 inch threshold.
  3. Place temporary wedge at entry doors for 1 inch threshold.
  
- Ward 15, Division 13, Storefront (Corner of Woodstock Street)
  1. Prop open both leaves of entry door.
  
- Ward 16, Division 13, Anna Pratt School (Primary Entrance: Susquehanna Avenue; Accessible Entrance: 22<sup>nd</sup> Street)

Temporary Measures:

1. Re-designate the 22<sup>nd</sup> Street entrance as the exclusive entrance.
2. Place 6 foot temporary ramp at 22<sup>nd</sup> Street entrance.

Permanent Measure:

1. Create permanent, compliant ramp on 22<sup>nd</sup> Street entrance or remove segment of 3 foot wide wall at 22<sup>nd</sup> Street entrance.
- Ward 16, Division 18, Love Zion Baptist Church (Primary Entrance: 23<sup>rd</sup> Street double narrow doors; Accessible Entrance: Ramped entrance on 23<sup>rd</sup> Street)
    1. Re-designate the ramped entrance on 23<sup>rd</sup> Street as the exclusive entrance.
    2. Prop open door at 23<sup>rd</sup> Street entrance.
    3. Add temporary edge protection to railings on exterior ramp.
  - Ward 25, Divisions 3, 8, Our Lady Help of Christians (Entrance with steps)
    1. Re-locate voting area to church garage.
  - Ward 25, Division 10, Mother of Divine Grace (2617 E. Cambria Street)
    1. Relocate voting area from the Grace Ministry office to the garage at the school entry.
  - Ward 25, Division 14, Mt. Zion Church of Kensington (We Care Learning Center, E. Somerset Street)
    1. Re-locate voting area to Church lobby.
    2. Prop open double doors at entrance to Church lobby.
  - Ward 26, Divisions 20, 23, 24, Open MRI (20<sup>th</sup> Street)
    1. Re-locate voting area to the rear room in the same building, using the side entrance at the parking lot.
    2. Prop open door at entrance to the rear room (above).
  - Ward 33, Division 4, Holy Innocents Rectory (Rectory Door)
    1. Re-locate voting area from rectory to gymnasium.
    2. Use side entrance to gymnasium from parking area.
  - Ward 34, Division 12, Simpson-Fletcher Methodist Church (Primary Entrance: Entrance on N. 61<sup>st</sup> Street & Jefferson Street; Accessible Entrance: Ramped entrance on N. 61<sup>st</sup> Street)
    1. Re-designate the accessible entrance as the exclusive entrance.

2. Prop open both leaves of double door at accessible entrance.

    1. Place 3 foot temporary ramp at building entrance.
    2. Prop open doors at building entrance.

    1. Prop open entrance door.
    2. Prop open screen door at entrance.
    3. Prop open gate door at entrance.

    1. Make the accessible entrance the exclusive entrance.
  - Ward 40, Division 33, Paschallville Library (Primary Entrance: 70<sup>th</sup> Street; Accessible Entrance: Woodland Avenue)
    1. Make the accessible entrance the exclusive entrance.
    2. Prop open the accessible entrance door.
  - Ward 40, Divisions 42, 44, Penrose School (78<sup>th</sup> Street)
    1. Prop open entrance door.
  - Ward 44, Division 19, Bible Way Sunday School Building (Master Street)
    1. Re-locate voting area to upper lobby or lower level fellowship hall in the Bible Way Baptist Church, using elevator in the main church building to access these areas.
  - Ward 46, Division 1, St. Francis de Sales (47<sup>th</sup> Street)
    1. Move voting area to the balcony/mezzanine level of the gym, which is located to the left of the entrance behind the church.

2. Place a 6 foot temporary ramp at the step of the exterior entrance to the balcony/mezzanine level of the gym.
  3. Prop open interior doors to the balcony/mezzanine level of the gym.
  4. Prop open the exterior entrance door to the balcony/mezzanine level of the gym.
- Ward 47, Division 14, New Life Baptist Church (Cecil B. Moore Avenue)
    1. Prop open interior vestibule doors.
    2. Prop open entrance doors.
  - Ward 48, Divisions 8, 12, 17, St. Edmond's Church (S. 21<sup>st</sup> Street)
    1. Move voting area from the basement to the formal dining room in St. Edmond's Rectory, using the ramped entrance from the parking lot.
  - Ward 58, Divisions 25, 40, St. Andrews in the Field Church (Somerton Avenue)
    1. Move voting area from existing site to church lobby.
    2. Prop open both entrance doors to church lobby.

**POLLING PLACES THAT ARE INACCESSIBLE AND SHOULD BE RELOCATED**

The following polling places have been surveyed by the United States and have been determined to be inaccessible under the standards agreed to in this case. The United States has further determined that temporary measures cannot be implemented to make the polling places accessible on election day. For this group of polling places, we recommend that each polling place be relocated to an existing polling place location or to another site. If the City determines that the relocation of a particular division is not possible, then the United States will continue to work with the City to locate an alternative location for the division.
