



Completion includes review and correction.

2. Assure that within 60 days of receipt of each assessment by the Supports Coordinator, an Individual Support Plan (ISP) team meeting takes place, and the assessment recommendations are placed in the class member's ISP with specificity. The ISP team meeting must include an opportunity for the member to make a fully informed decision about the recommendations, or if appropriate, the development of a plan to gradually introduce the individual to the proposed services or items so that he or she can make an informed decision.

3. Monitor, on an ongoing basis, to assure that the assessment recommendations are correctly presented in the ISP with specificity, that recommended communication supports are offered to participants, that participants were given the opportunity to make informed choices about communication supports, and to ensure that selected services and supports are provided expeditiously.

4. In order to assist the Deaf Services Coordinator in implementing paragraphs 2 and 3 above, and paragraphs g-k of the Amended Settlement Agreement, hire or contract with individuals or entities as necessary to ensure that: 1) monitoring can occur for all class members

within 90 days of each ISP team meeting and in response to class members' complaints and any necessary follow-up can be provided; 2) technical assistance is available to class members and providers as needed; 3) providers of recommended services, including but not limited to AT evaluations, Communication Specialists, interpreters, and residential and day providers with the ability to provide effective communication (including but not limited to fully signing environments), are recruited and made available to fulfill the accepted recommendations in the assessments; 4) reassessments and initial assessments for new class members are conducted in a timely manner; and 5) the system contemplated in paragraph 2j is in place by the end of 2018.

6. The parties hereby agree to amend the time period for which the Settlement Agreement remains in effect to two and a half years after all the initial completed assessments for class members known as of March 1, 2018 are added to the ISPs with specificity.

7. Defendant will provide Plaintiff's counsel with monthly reports of progress on each of the items described above until, with respect to all class members known as of March 1, 2018, the communication assessment recommendations are included with specificity in their ISPs

and at least one monitoring, as described in paragraph 3 of this Addendum has occurred. Defendants will then provide Plaintiffs' counsel with quarterly reports of progress on each of the terms described in the Amended Settlement Agreement and the Addendum until court jurisdiction ends or until the parties agree that less frequent reporting will be sufficient. This paragraph replaces Paragraph 14 of the Amended Settlement Agreement


.8. No later than three (3) weeks after the Court approves this Settlement Agreement Addendum, Defendant will mail individual Notices to all class members and their legal representatives (or in the absence of a legal representative, a family member or primary contact) advising them of this Addendum including a summary of its provisions. Plaintiff's counsel will post the Notice on their website in English and ASL, and will make the full Addendum available upon request.

9. The original Amended Settlement Agreement shall remain in effect except to the extent it is in conflict with this Addendum. Paragraphs 24 and 25 of the Amended Settlement Agreement related to enforcement apply to this Addendum.


10. Defendant shall pay Plaintiff's counsel \$25,000 in attorney's fees for counsel's work in pursuing the Motion to Enforce Settlement

Agreement. Defendant shall process the necessary paperwork for payment to be made within 30 days of the Court order approving the amendment.
