Why does Census 2020 matter?

An incorrect census can have an incredible ripple affect over people with disabilities and the organizations and people that serve them. It is for that reason every citizen must participate and disabled people should be specially prepared given the potential ramifications on their everyday lives.

Until the census has been completed, Disability Rights Pennsylvania will be educating disabled Pennsylvanians about the programs and services that may be threatened due to an incorrect count of people with disabilities and which questions to which to pay close attention. How do I complete my census questionnaire?

According to the Census Bureau, 95% of households will receive a request to complete the census by mail. Once received, people can respond online, by mail or by phone.



When can I expect my census invitation?



March 10th-20th
Initial invitation sent to households.

March 16th-20th
A reminder letter will be sent.

March 26th-April 3rd
Reminder postcard to households.

April 8th-16th
Reminder letter and paper questionnaire sent.

April 20th-27th
Final reminder postcard before census bureau follows up in person.
